Your attendance for 3 hours each week is mandatory and you must complete additional work outside of class time.

Assessment

Assessment of your progress is throughout the course. However, you will be assessed by three externally marked exams in May/June. It's important to note that these dates are fixed and set nationally, so they cannot be changed.
