You are not required to be working in a health and social care setting or to undertake practical placements as part of this course as this is a knowledge based course. – however, we will support you in finding work experience as this will enhance your CV and improve your future job prospects.

The course will cover the type of job roles and services within it, the role of communication and the importance of valuing the individuals being cared for. How is the qualification structured? The Award requires 6 credits.
